



## Curved Wall, Mosaic Tile, Bridge M46 Project

Presented by the Tulare County Resource Management Agency and the Arts Consortium (Tulare County's arts council).

The purpose of this art tile project is to beautify a Tulare County owned bridge; to procure four (4) unmounted art tiles that feature flora and fauna endemic to our region; as well as to raise awareness of the great artists in Tulare County.

Proposal guidelines: Please submit proposals for segmented, mosaic art tiles. Each full tile composition must be designed as separate, unmounted tiles that will be installed by county staff. Each full tile composition should be designed with no more than 8-12 separate segments.

The unmounted mosaic-style proposals designs should allow the Resource Management Agency to mount the art tiles so that they will conform smoothly to the curved wingwall of the bridge, using grout between the segments (overall size must account for grout line separations).

### SUMMARY:

- 4 Tiles
- OVERALL MEASUREMENTS MUST NOT EXCEED: 1.5' ft. tall by 3' ft. long, and of no more than 1" in. deep at the edges
- **To be considered, submissions must incorporate ONE of the following creatures into each tile design:**
  - **Bobcat (*Lynx rufus*)**
  - **Black Bear (*Ursus americanus*)**
  - **Striped Adobe Lily (*Fritillaria striata*)**
  - **Berry's Morning Glory (*Calystegia malacophylla* var. *berryi*)**

There is no cost to apply.

Submit one(1) detailed proposal for four(4) mosaic tiles.

The proposals must be submitted in .pdf format to [hello@artsconsortium.org](mailto:hello@artsconsortium.org) with the word "Bridge" in the title BEFORE Wednesday, August 6th at 11:59PM.

Application email must include:

- Artist bio paragraph and contact information (phone number, email, mailing address, physical address [if different from mailing address])
- Pictures, digital sketches, or hand drawn plans for your mosaic tiles at a 1.5' height by 3' width.
- Images of your previous work (art tile, mosaic, ceramic, stonework, etc.).
- A project timeline from the beginning of production to the delivery of the finished tiles.

The selected artist will receive a total project budget of \$12,000. Half of the total budget will be delivered to the artist to signal the beginning of the production portion of the project, and the second half will be paid upon the safe delivery of the finished tiles.

Once they are completed, the tiles will be installed on the recently renovated bridge located on W. Oakwood Dr. over Capinero Creek, near Pine Flat.
