

## ART TILE BRIDGE PROJECT

Presented by the Tulare County Resource Management Agency and the Arts Consortium (Tulare County's arts council). The purpose of this art tile project is to beautify a Tulare County owned bridge; to feature flora and fauna endemic to our region; as well as to raise awareness of the great artists in Tulare County.

There is no cost to apply.

Submit detailed proposals for two(2) mosaic tiles.

The proposals must be submitted in .pdf format to hello@artsconsortium.org with the word "Bridge" in the title BEFORE Monday, September 1st at 11:59PM.

Application email must include:

- Artist bio paragraph and contact information (phone number, email, mailing address, physical address [if different from mailing address]
- Pictures, digital sketches, or hand drawn plans for your mosaic tiles at a <u>1'-10" height by 1'10" width and</u> no more than 1" deep at the edges.
- Images of your previous work (art tile, mosaic, ceramic, stonework, etc.).
- A project timeline from the beginning of production to the delivery of the finished tiles.

The selected artist will receive a total project budget of \$5,000. Half of the total budget will be delivered to the artist to signal the beginning of the production portion of the project, and the second half will be paid upon the safe delivery of the finished tiles.

Once they are completed, the tiles will be installed on the recently renovated Old Stage Coach Road Bridge over White River (approximately set between Ducor and California Hot Springs).

To be considered, submissions must incorporate one of the following creatures into each tile design:

- Fisher (Pekania pennanti)
- Keck's Checker-mallow (Sidalcea keckii)
- Acorn Woodpecker (Melanerpes formicivorus)
- Red-Tailed Hawk (Buteojamaicensis)
- Western Pond Turtle (Actinemys marmorata)
- Monarch Butterfly (Danausplexippus)
