- You will receive an email reply notifying you of space availability.
- Only 8 reservations spots available. Reservations are on a first-come-first-served basis.
- If all spots have been reserved you will have the option to reserve for a future month.

GUIDELINES

- No current fee to participate
- Portfolio max size: 11" x 17"
- Regardless of your art medium, your portfolio should only include photographs of your work.
- Portfolios will be on display at designated tables for the duration of the community meeting and half hour before meeting starts.
- Artists are encouraged to provide their business cards, artist postcards, or include a QR code to their information in their portfolio.
- A trigger and/or 18+ themes disclaimer in portfolio, when applicable, is required. See next page for details.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Trigger and 18+ Themes Portfolio Disclaimer

You are required to include a trigger and/or 18+ themes disclaimer in portfolio, when applicable. If your portfolio contains themes that would require a trigger and/or 18+ themes disclaimer (this can include but not limited to alcohol, drugs, nudity, political themes, religious themes, etc.) please provide one at the beginning of your portfolio or before the art piece. If you require help with the phrasing of this disclaimer, please let us know so that we can help you avoid any issues.

Subject for Review

Portfolios are subject for review prior to display during our Community Meeting. If your portfolio does not include the required disclaimers when they are necessary, or in extreme cases of graphic or otherwise controversial content, regardless of the presence of a disclaimer, Arts Consortium staff may ask you to remove the artwork from your portfolio and from the premises. Artists are welcome to send samples of their portfolio ahead of time to seek Arts Consortium staff feedback and guidance.

Compliance

If an artist does not comply to the above guidelines and terms & conditions, it may affect their participation in future Arts Consortium showcases and they may be barred from showing their work on the night of our Community Meeting.

Stand-by Participation

Artists who do not sign up but bring their portfolio will not be turned away. If space allows, additional portfolios may be selected for exhibit at our Community Meeting, and will be considered at a first-come-first serve basis.
